

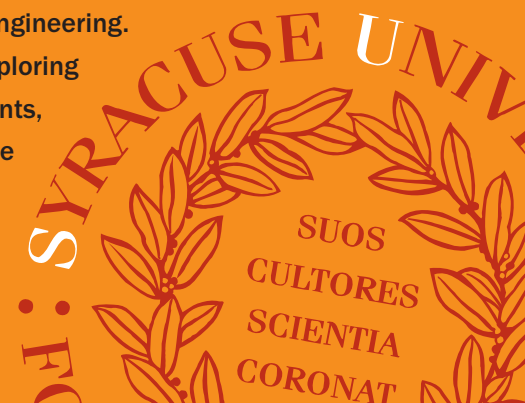


MILT & ANN STEVENSON INCITING A PASSION FOR BIOMEDICAL RESEARCH
