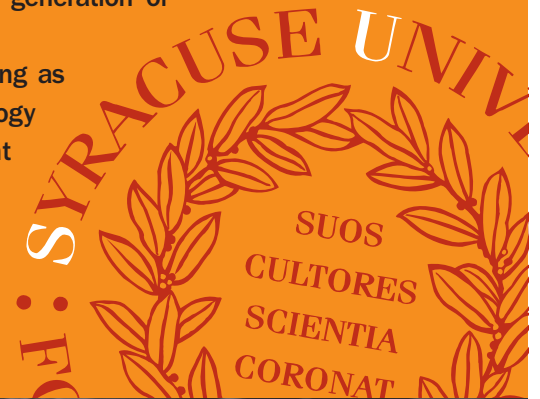


# JPMORGAN CHASE & CO. INCITING UNIVERSITY-INDUSTRY COLLABORATIONS
